This book scholarship was established in memory of Michael Partin, who was a Covington police officer and NKU alumnus, by his family and fellow police officers. Officer Partin died while in pursuit of a suspect in 1998. To be eligible for the **\$500 scholarship**, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a **fully admitted student** in any of the majors within the Department of Political Science and Criminal Justice – political science, criminal justice, public administration, international studies or organizational leadership;
2. Be of **senior standing** by the end of the Spring semester;
3. Have completed a **minimum of twelve hours** within the Department of Political Science and Criminal Justice;
4. Have a minimum **cumulative grade point average of 3.00**;
5. Be pursuing a career within the **law enforcement**; and
6. Have a **faculty member** from the Department of Political Science and Criminal Justice **endorse your application**.

An applicant must submit a **250-word typed essay** describing his/her career goals and reasons why he/she is interested in a law enforcement career. The essay should be attached to the application form.

The application deadline is **Friday, March 27 at 5 p.m.** There are two ways to submit an application:
